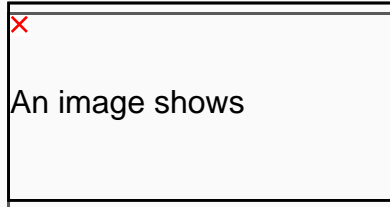


Countdown to NDEAM 2014
